Procedure for reporting crimes:

All crimes in the above categories are referred immediately to the Los Angeles Police Department. The Director or Staff Member will call the police department for you and assist you with follow-up with the Police Department, if necessary. Non-emergency police reporting number is (213) 485-4061.

All crimes reported will be logged in and become a part of the next published campus crime statistics. Students will be notified immediately, via their instructors, if a crime occurs that represents an immediate threat to students on campus.
