STUDENT RIGHT TO KNOW

PERFORMANCE FACT SHEET

The Student Right-To-Know Act (Publ. 105-18) requires schools to disclose information about graduation rates to current and prospective students and the public. The Right-To-Know regulations define the reporting period to be based on starting September 1 and ending on August 31 of each year.

Diversified Language Institute, Los Angeles and Torrance, in complying with the Right-to-Know Act, discloses the following graduation rates for the enrollment period of **September 1, 2009 through August 31, 2010**.

Vocational English as a Second Language

The school enrolled 664 students. Three hundred and ninety one (391 = 59%) students completed their training within 150% of the normal time to graduate. The remaining two hundred and seventy three students (273 = 41%) either did not graduate or did not complete within the 150% of the normal time to graduate.

Business Office Administration

The school enrolled 99 students. Sixty-four (64 = 65%) students completed their training within 150% of the normal time to graduate. The remaining thirty-five (35 = 35%) either did not graduate or did not complete within the 150% of the normal time to graduate.
